Trademark description

The mark is a two-dimensional design and consists of a stylized maple leaf design with a hockey player with the word Canada on the front of the hockey jersey and striping on the sleeves and front and back of the hockey jersey. An eleven-point maple leaf with the word Canada is on each sleeve of the hockey jersey. A maple leaf pattern is visible on the shoulder cap and striping on the sleeves and front and back of the hockey jersey. The attached drawing shows two aspects of the same mark, front and back. The object shown in dotted outline does not form part of the mark

Disclaimer text

The right to the exclusive use of of the word CANADA and the representation of the 11 pointed maple leaf is disclaimed apart from the trademark.

Colour claim

Colour is claimed as a feature of the trade-mark. The colours black, red and white are claimed as a feature of the mark. The body of the red

hockey jersey consists of stylized maple leaf design with a hockey player set out in red, white and black along with the word Canada underneath in white. The sleeves and front and back striping and shoulder cap are in black. An eleven-point maple leaf with the word Canada on each sleeve is in red
