Re: 2.5 GHz MCS Toronto and Ottawa

The Department has noted that Bell Canada has chosen not to participate in the upcoming MCS licensing process nor to request the Department to grandfather - with a learning plan-your existing 2.5 GHz MCS systems in Toronto and Ottawa.

Thus, in accordance with the 2.5 GHz MCS licensing policy entitled "2500 MHZ Multipoint Communications Systems Policy and Licensing Procedures", as an incumbent licensee in this band you will have two years to vacate your current assignments. This letter is to confirm that Bell Canada will cease to operate the two 2.5 GHz MCS systems in Toronto and Ottawa effective on October 12, 2001.
