This is a matter which was the subject of a previous consultation in May 2012 - <u>SMSE-010-12</u> - on which your department has taken no action. Please include the Amateur Service as a secondary service in this band.

B3 (AI 1.23) — Secondary Amateur Allocation in the 415 to 526.5 kHz Range

I support the revision as presented in your consultation paper.
